

Care and Cleaning Transcript

[00:00:03] Well now that you have your new enclosed porch one of the things that everybody wants to know about is how to clean these units. So here are a few of the items that you're going to need to clean them. First and foremost, you need two microfiber cloths. One that's going to be wet and one that's going to be dry. You also need your can of vinyl cleaner. And you need some type of Swiffer or duster for the screens. This is just your traditional Swiffer and this is just a different style of one. So either one of these works really well to clean the screens. I suggest that you always clean the screens when you clean the panels because the dirt collects on the screens. Then if it rains it will transfer onto your vinyl panels. So, I just take this and I just Swiffer the screen on

[00:00:59] both sides. And I always do that before I start to clean my vinyl. Then I get a bucket of just clean water. I prefer a warm water. Use one of my microfiber rags in the water.

[00:01:30] And the other one I'll keep dry. Another thing you want to make sure that you do is squeeze out all the excess water from your microfiber cloth. Just makes it a lot easier and quicker to clean. Then you take your panel. And you simply wipe it. And immediately you're going to want to dry it off with the dry cloth. Turn around do the same thing on the other side

[00:02:22] Wipe it with the wet side and immediately dry it off. That's how you clean the panels. Then you're going to just put them back in one at a time just like you took them out.

[00:02:46] Once a year we suggested that you use the vinyl cleaner and preservative on the vinyl. It's going to help it stay supple and help with getting any water spots off of them. This is a great way to keep your vinyl porch looking new for years.
