

Measuring an Opening Transcript

[00:00:02] Hi, I'm Charlie with LivingSpace Sunrooms, I'm the Technical Director, and today I'm going to show you how to measure for your new Porch Conversions window. First thing I like to do is check my sill to make sure that it's level. And in this particular case, this one is perfectly level. I also like to check to make sure that the side is plum and we are very nice and plum here. The next thing we want to do is check across the width in three locations. We want to measure across the bottom, the middle and the top. And we want to note those three numbers. We also want to check the height of our opening again in three locations. We want to check on the left, in the middle.

[00:00:50] and on the right. And note those three numbers. When ordering your window, you're going to want to use the smallest of the dimensions that we just took to make sure that your window is going to fit properly in the opening. You have the option to give us the exact size. You can downsize the window yourself; tell us what you want it to be, or you can give us a rough opening and we will downsize it a quarter of an inch, which leaves you a nice eight inch reveal to center your window up in the opening. If you have an opening that is out of square, we will have information to follow that will guide you on how to properly measure and submit for an out of square opening.
